- a) If the line on your side is a Solid line you can cross or straddle it overtake but only if it is safe to do.
- b) If the line on your side is a Pedestrian crossing you must not cross or straddle it.
- c) A Stop line indicates where you are required to stop when directed by a traffic officer or red traffic officer light.
- d) A Box junction is a box with yellow coloured diagonal lines. In this marked area, vehicle must not stop even briefly.
- e) Broken line are alternate black and white stripes painted parallel to the road. You must stop and give way to pedestrian at these crossing.
